Scholarship Application*

Chun University offers a variety of privately funded academic scholarships and awards. Students must maintain a full-time academic course load to be eligible for any financial aid. Scholarship applications will be considered on the basis of need and academics.

Scholarships:

1. Honors Scholarships: Each year, scholarships ranging up to 100% tuition will be awarded to entering freshmen who have shown extraordinary academic achievement and outstanding leadership and demonstration of character in their community, church, or school. (To apply: In addition to the information requested in the checklist, please submit a one-page essay on leadership. Provide a definition of leadership, a biblical definition and example of leadership, and a description of how you are an effective leader in your community, church, or school.)
2. Presidential Scholarships: Prospective incoming freshmen with exemplary academic history and test scores are eligible for these awards. These are based on a combination of SAT (1100) or ACT (26) scores and high school GPA (3.50 on 4.00 standard scale). GPA of 3.25 at CU is required for scholarship renewal. (Honors Scholars are ineligible for this award.)
3. Music Competition Scholarship: Monies range up to 100% of tuition to students who have won any type of award at CU's annual music performance competition or at any other music competition.
4. Chun Group Scholarships: Each year, scholarships ranging from 30-100% of tuition will be awarded by constituents of the Chun Group to entering freshmen who have shown extraordinary academic achievement and outstanding leadership and character. (Honors Scholars are ineligible for this award.) (To apply: In addition to the information requested in the checklist, please submit a one-page essay on leadership. Provide a definition of leadership, a biblical definition and example of leadership, and a description of how you are an effective leader in your community, church, or school.)
5. The Hymn Society of Korea Scholarship: Students who are members of The Hymn Society of Korea or are recommended by the Society's Committee of Scholarship may be eligible to receive this award. The amount of the award is variable and contingent upon the decision of the Society's committee. The award is renewable upon application.

Apprenticeships:

1. Opera Carolina Apprenticeship
2. Royal Opera Group Apprenticeship

***NOTE:** Chun University is a newly started college, fully approved by the North Carolina Board of Education. We are in the process of seeking accreditation. Until approved for accreditation, we are not eligible for Federal funds including Pell Grants, Federal Student Loans (subsidized or unsubsidized), or other federally funded programs. All scholarships are in-house or are privately funded by supporters of Chun University. Other private scholarships or grants will be considered only upon appropriate documentation when submitted to a representative of the Admissions Office.
